

## 2025-2026 ALCS Transportation Information

Families that need transportation will need to follow the instructions, listed below, for their specific zoned home school district to submit the request. Most districts require parents to go to the district office, in person, to register their child for transportation to and from Albany Leadership Charter School for Girls.

District-provided transportation follows their specific district academic calendar.

Transportation will not be provided to ALCS students on days their home school district is not open.

Please be sure to note that we have combined buildings. Both ALMS and ALHS are located at 19 Hackett Blvd., Albany, NY 12208.

Albany	CDTA	In the Albany City District, students who live 1.5 miles or greater from ALCS receive a CDTA Swiper Card to ride CDTA (public transportation). Students living less than 1.5 miles or outside of the Albany area are not eligible for a CDTA Swiper. School Bus	Lansingburgh Central School District requires district students attending Private, Parochial, and/or Charter Schools to submit annually a request for transportation services. School Bus	Students who reside within the Troy City School District and plan to attend a private, charter, or parochial school must submit a Transportation Request Form. This form is located on the Troy CSD (troycsd.org) website. <i>Troy CSD does NOT provide transportation when their District is closed.</i> The form must be fully completed and returned to Central Registration Office, TCSD, 475 First St., Troy, NY 12180

School Bus	Transportation will be provided to non-public schools for students who live within 15 miles of the school.
