We'd just like to provide you with some updates and reminders. Albany Leadership still DOES NOT have any confirmed cases of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), however, we have been working diligently to thoroughly clean and disinfect our building, with particular attention paid to "high-touch" surfaces. Please be advised that, by Governor Cuomo's Executive Order, ALH will be closed through April 1st, with an anticipated return to classes April 2nd. There will be no classes or school activities, and the building will be closed to students and visitors. The building is also closed to ALL STAFF, tomorrow, Tuesday, March 17th. ALH staff will report on WEDNESDAY, MARCH 18th, at 8:00 a.m., to finalize plans and resources for distance learning. ALH will provide grab-and-go meals to students daily throughout the closure, beginning Thursday, March 19th, from 11:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. ALH will follow up with detailed information for students and families regarding meal pick-up and technology access Wednesday, March 18th, and we will continue to provide you with regular updates throughout the duration of the school closure.
